

## ROAD DEPARTMENT SCHEDULE FOR FEBRUARY AND MARCH OF 2011

**ALAMOGORDO CREW:** Spring clean-up, get ready for flood season in various locations around the County. We will be cleaning and reshaping bar ditches, installing new culverts, cleaning and inspecting culverts. We will also start hauling half inch chip to various stockpiles around the County for our upcoming state chip seal projects. Also install cattle guards on ranch road B-023 North of Tularosa.

**PINON CREW:** Finish hauling base coarse on Miller Road inside of Miller Flats. Haul material on F-001 Bebo Lee ranch road to fix intersection leading to shipping pins. Haul creek bed gravel from the Cornucopia crossings to G-024 George Rauch ranch road to mix with caliche to fix powdered out areas spanning over one mile. Start state project in Timberon.

**DISTRICT A&B BLADE MAN:** Currently blading on NM 506 South of Alamogordo, also has a 6000 hour service. Will continue working North and West blading County roads around the Riata Road area continuing North until he reaches 3-Rivers Ranch. He will then return to Tularosa and blade all County roads in need of attention East of Tularosa until reaching Bent NM.

**DISTRICT C BLADE MAN:** Currently doing a 9000 hour service on grader there is also some leaks that need to be addressed while it is in the shop. When he returns to district he will start in Mayhill NM blading the lower county roads in James Canyon working up to Sixteen Springs Canyon, continuing through to Lower Sixteen, Walker, Dry Burnt etc. Will then move to Lower Cox Canyon Blading County roads up the canyon. Bear, Wills, Rio Penasco Etc.

**DISTRICT D BLADE MAN:** Finish Miller Road in Miller Flats, and blade entire road from NM Hwy 130 to NM Hwy 24. Blade McDonald Flat and Mule Canyon also work on crossings in these areas to open them up before rainy season. Remain in the lower elevations, blading Chimney Lake and Dog Canyon areas, also working on getting crossings in these areas opened up so that flood waters may flow more freely.

**DISTRICT E BLADE MAN:** Finish cutting brush along the Sac River Road. Blade the Sac River Road continuing North into Timberon NM. Blade county Roads within the Village of Timberon NM.

**DISTRICT F BLADE MAN:** Just completed a 8000 hour service. Returned to district and will start blading County road F-052 east to the Dixie cut off. Also Blade F-001 South and any County roads in-between that will require attention until reaching the state line.

**DISTRICT G BLADE MAN:** Currently finishing up by Stewart and Kinkade ranches off of Jernigan Draw. Will blade the Dixie Highway. Also will blade Brownfield Hill and will blade G-042 by Pop Snows. Will assist the Pinon Crew in the repair of County road G-024. The homestead of George Rauch.
